

Security instructions for sailing with small vessels

Which vessel apply this security instructions for?

Group of vessels/canoes:

8 pieces Hobie Pro Angler 12, 6 olives and 2 dune and 2 Hobie Outfitter, 2 dune.

Kayaks for rent to sail in the following areas:

- The entire Helnæs Bay - max 200 meters from the coast
- The waters around Horneland - from the left side of Bøjden Ferry Port to Sinebjerg Camping max 200 meters from the coast.
- When the water temp. below 10 ° C, air temp. below 10 ° C, visibility below 10 meters, and Wind force 6 s / m, we recommended not canoeing more than 100 meters from the shore.
- November to March 1 for rent no kayaks, unless the user is wearing survivalsuit.

Actions to mitigate risk

Version: October 23, 2012

- By poor or swimming capabilities, offer lifejacket instead of swim vest.
- Inform about the passengers before the canoeing trip.
- Demonstration of the turning around of the kayak and how to board it again, and demonstration of the kayaks equipment and the use of this.
- Waves from other vessels: steer the kayak toward the waves in order to prevent the kayak from capsizing.
- Use the paddle as additional propellant to navigate to the shore -
- In case of exhaustion: use the umbrella anchor and regain your strength before continuation.

Description of the vessel and the equipment

Best practice related to the kayaks

Hobie Pro Angler 12 and Hobie Outfitter is an extremely stable fishing kayak. The width (91 and 86 cm) and the hull insures high buoyancy, and the kayaks are unsinkable. There are drainage holes which makes it self-bailing. Propulsion is done via Mirage drive system where the feet are active, and arms are free. The paddle is additional aid.

The kayak equipment and how it is used:

CE approved life jackets, Mirage Drive System, paddle, map of sail area with relevant phone numbers in need of help, Tenant's own (fully charged) cellphone, in waterproof container, umbrella anchor, tow rope, first aid box. Everything is checked, washed and lubricated after every turn on the water and replaced as required.

Requirements of the kayak Passengers:

Wear approved life jacket during all canoeing, and only in the areas the "Shipowner" has directed.

The kayaks must not be sailed by drunk or intoxicated persons. Smoking is prohibited in the kayaks.

The kayaks are not to be rented to persons under the age of 18 years, unless accompanied by an adult.

The kayaks are not to be rented to drunk or otherwise intoxicated passengers or persons who for other reasons deemed unsuitable by the "shipowner".

Crew size and skills.

- There must be maximum one person in the Hobie Pro Angler while sailing. Capacity: 227 kg
- There must be max 2 persons Hobie Outfitter during sailing. Capacity: 193 kg
- Wear approved life jacket during all sailing, sail by conditions in the area
- Respect what the "Shipowner" has directed according to the sailing and canoe areas

aphical limitations, times of day / year, and the maximum number of persons on board:

Kayaks for rent to sail in the following areas:

- The entire Helnæs Bay - max 200 meters from the coast
- The waters around Horneland - from the left side of Bøjden Ferry Port to Sinebjerg
- Camping max 200 meters from the coast.
- When the water temp. below 10 ° C, air temp. below 10 ° C, visibility below 10 meters, and Wind force 6 s / m or above, we recommended not canoeing more than 100 meters from the coast.
- Canoeing is allowed from sunrise to sunset.
- There must be maximum one person in the Hobie Pro Angler while sailing.
- There must be max 2 persons Hobie Outfitter during sailing.
- 1 November to March 1 canoeing is only allowed if the passengers are wearing a survival suit.

In case of shipwreck capsizing and fire:

"Shipowner" shows how the kayak is reversed if capsizing and how to restore its further sailing capabilities.

If the tenant is driven into the open sea or otherwise is in danger of his or others' life, the bailout (SOK) is to be contacted if it is deemed they can not come ashore.

The passengers can at anytime call the "shipowner" who has a motorboat ready in Bøjden Fiskerihavn.

Passengers in the kayaks are informed, always to bring fully charged mobile phones, with relevant numbers in waterproof container.

In order to be readily available in case of a rescue, the shipowner always ensures (in writing) to be informed about canoeing departure and expected arrival, and information on the number of passengers.

“Shipowner” notes and keep in writing, whom, which and how many kayaks are rented as well as departure and expected time of return.

All passengers will sign the responsibility and safety instructions paper (kept by the “shipowner”)

Measures taken to ensure that safety instruction are always given

Before canoeing “Shipowner” explains the correct use of the rented kayak and its equipment with the passengers. In addition, read the safety instructions for/with the passengers

Renter must present a full charged mobile before departure.

Follow-up

When adverse events associated with sailing occurs, these will be discussed with the parties involved, in order to clarify the course of events and to make adjustments of these safety instructions.
